THE STATES BOARD OF EMPLOYMENT, INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Health and Safety (Fees) (Guernsey) Law, 1993 (a) hereby makes the following Order:-

Fees to be payable under Explosives Law.

1. The following fees shall be payable under and for the purposes of the following provisions of the Explosives (Guernsey) Law, 1905 (b)-

- (i) under article VIII ("licences pour provision"),  
a fee of £25.00;
- (ii) under article XXIX ("honoraires"),
  - Factory Licence ("licence d'usine") £100.00
  - Renewal 50.00
  - Amendment 50.00
  
  - Magazine Licence ("licence d'entrepot") 50.00
  - Renewal 25.00
  - Amendment 20.00
  
  - Store Licence ("licence de magasin") 25.00
  - Renewal 20.00
  
  - House Licence ("licence de maison") 20.00
  - Renewal 15.00
  
  - Importation Licence 10.00
  - + 50 pence per 100 lbs  
explosive content
  
  - Temporary Licence under  
article IV of the Law 25.00

Fees to be payable under Petroleum Law.

2. The following fees shall be payable under and for the purposes of the following provisions of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Huiles ou Essences Minerales ou autres substances de la meme nature, 1924"(c)-

- (i) under article 2(1) (fees payable in respect of discharge of inflammable oils), an annual fee of £25.00;
- (ii) under article 2(3) (fees for applications for licences for storage of inflammable oils), a fee of:-
  - (a) for a quantity not exceeding 500 galls £15.00;
  - (b) for a quantity not exceeding 2,000 galls 25.00;
  - (c) for a quantity not exceeding 20,000 galls 35.00;
  - (d) for a quantity not exceeding 50,000 galls 50.00;
  - (e) for a quantity not exceeding 100,000 galls 75.00;
  - (f) for quantities greater than 100,000 galls 100.00;
- (iii) under article 2(4) (fees for services rendered by Inspector in connection with construction of places for storage of inflammable oils), a fee of £25.00 per hour or part thereof; and
- (iv) under article 2(8) (fees payable upon grant or renewal of licence for storage of inflammable oils), a fee of:-
  - (a) for quantities not exceeding 500 galls £15.00;
  - (b) for quantities not exceeding 2,000 galls 25.00;
  - (c) for quantities not exceeding 20,000 galls 35.00;
  - (d) for quantities not exceeding 50,000 galls 50.00;
  - (e) for quantities not exceeding 100,000 galls 75.00;
  - (f) for quantities greater than 100,000 galls 100.00.

Fees to be payable under Health and Safety legislation.

3. The following fees shall be payable to the States for the grant, renewal or variation of the following licences, or applications therefor, or the provision of the following services or documents, under or for the purposes of the Health, Safety and Welfare of Employees Law, 1950(d), the Health and Safety at Work etc.(Guernsey) Law, 1979(e) and any Ordinance or other subordinate legislation made under them.
- (a) for the granting of a scaffold permit £10.00
  - (b) for the analysis of samples referred for specialist examination 50.00
  - (c) Poisonous Substances Importers Licence 50.00
  - Poisonous Substances Spraying Contractors Licence 50.00
  - Poisonous Substances Use of Licensed Chemicals 10.00
  - (d) Provision of factual reports (on the basis of time expended in their preparation) at 25.00 per hour or part thereof.

Interpretation

4. (1) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(f) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.
- (2) Any reference in this order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.
