The Health Service (Medical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995

Made 21 March 1995
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st April 1995

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 6 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. The schedule to the Health Service (Medical Benefit) Regulations, 1990(b) is hereby amended deleting paragraph (i) thereof and substituting the following:-

- "(i) undertaking cosmetic dermatology using collagen implant techniques;
- (j) any other non-medical reason."


Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995.

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Medical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, by adding "undertaking cosmetic dermatology using collagen implant techniques" to the list of exclusions from the expression "consultation for a medical purpose".
