The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section six of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978(a), as amended(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation nineteen of the principal regulations

1. Immediately after paragraph (5) of regulation nineteen of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978(c), as amended(d), there is hereby inserted the following paragraph -

" (6) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (4) and paragraph (5) of this regulation, where an employer has contravened any of those provisions, the Authority may direct that employer to deliver or send to the Authority's office, within the period during which that employer is required to record any contributions in accordance with paragraph (1) or paragraph (3) of this regulation, a remittance for those contributions together with a statement in such form as the Authority shall determine and containing

such particulars as the Authority shall direct; and any failure to comply with any direction of the Authority under this paragraph shall be deemed to be a failure to comply with this regulation."

Citation and collective title

2.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983.

(2) These regulations and the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1982, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1983. *see s. 27/83*

Commencement

3. These regulations shall come into force on the sixteenth day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purpose.)

Paragraph (4) of regulation nineteen of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, provides that an employer shall deliver or send to the Insurance Authority's office, within fifteen days next following the expiration of a contribution quarter, a

remittance for the contributions recorded as being payable on the appropriate contribution schedule for that quarter.

Paragraph (5) of that regulation provides that an employer employing in any employment in any month more than 80 persons shall so deliver or send, within the fifteen days next following the expiration of that month, a remittance for the contributions recorded as being payable on the appropriate contribution schedule in respect of the earnings of those persons paid in that month.

The contributions payable in respect of an employee's earnings which are paid weekly must be recorded in accordance with that regulation within the seven days next following the expiration of the week in which those earnings are paid. The contributions payable in respect of an employee's earnings which are paid monthly must be so recorded within the fifteen days next following the expiration of the month in which those earnings are paid.

The purpose of these Regulations is to empower the Authority to direct in any case where an employer has failed to deliver or send a remittance for contributions in accordance with the said paragraph (4), to deliver or send to the Authority's office a remittance for contributions within the period during which the contributions must be recorded on the appropriate contribution schedule.
