THE ANIMALS (EXTENSION OF DEFINITION) ORDER, 1981

The States Committee for Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (2) of section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

1. During the continuance in force of this Order, the definition of "animals" in section fifteen of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, shall be read and have effect as if the words "cats and dogs" were included therein for the purposes of subsection (1) of section eleven and of section fourteen of that Ordinance.
2. Any reference in this Order to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Order.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, (b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it shall apply to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twentieth day of March 1981.
