THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY)


(PERSONAL RELIEFS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1989

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section 21 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions)(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972, and Subsection four of Section four of the European Communities (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1973, and in implementation of the obligations of the Bailiwick under the provisions of Protocol No.3 annexed to the Treaty relating to the accession of the United Kingdom to the European Economic Community and to the European Atomic Energy Community, hereby orders:-

1. The Customs and Excise (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Personal Reliefs) Order 1974 (a) as amended (b) is hereby further amended as follows:-
  - (a) In Section 2 the words "the Schedule" shall be deleted and "Schedule 1" shall be inserted in their place.
  - (b) In Paragraph (iv) of Section 3 immediately after the word "aircraft" the full stop shall be deleted and there shall be inserted, "except that any person who is a member of the paid crew of a ship and who either pays off from the ship or proceeds on leave for a period of more than five days on arrival in the Bailiwick shall be relieved from payment of any duty of customs or impot on goods of the descriptions and in the quantities shown in Schedule 2 to this Order."
  - (c) In the current Schedule to the Order the figure "1" shall be inserted after the word "Schedule".
  - (d) After Schedule 1 shall be inserted the new Schedule 2, attached to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. (i) This order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Personal Reliefs) (Amendment) Order 1989.  
(ii) This Order shall come into operation on the Sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.

SCHEDULE 2

<u>Description of Goods</u>	<u>Quantity</u>
1. <u>Tobacco Products</u> -	
Cigarettes ... ..	100
or	
Cigarillos (Cigars with a maximum weight each of 3 grammes) ...	50
or	
Cigars ... ..	25
or	
Other tobacco or tobacco products ... ..	125 grammes
2. <u>Alcoholic Beverages</u> -	
(a) with an alcoholic strength exceeding 22% by volume	¼ litre
or	
(b) with an alcoholic strength not exceeding 22% by volume	½ litre
or	
(c) fortified wines and sparkling wines ... ..	¾ litre
and	
(d) still wines (other than fortified wines) ... ..	1 litre
3. <u>Articles of any other description</u>	
Articles to a total value of £15 (subject to a limit of 50 litres of either beer or cider or of a combination of either beer or cider).	

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order further amends the Customs and Excise (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Personal Reliefs) Order 1974 by providing a personal allowance to a person who is a member of the paid crew of a ship who either pays off from the ship or proceeds on leave for a period of more than five days on arrival in the Bailiwick. There is no provision for any allowance for any person who is a member of the paid crew of a ship under the existing Order.
