The Fuel (Control) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Bailiwick
of Guernsey) Order, 1974

Made 22nd March, 1974

Coming into operation 22nd March, 1974

The States of Guernsey Emergency Council, as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, and the States of Alderney Finance Committee, as respects the Island of Alderney, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them respectively by subsection (1) of section two of the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act 1973, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act 1973 (Guernsey) Order, 1973, and of all other powers enabling them respectively in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Fuel (Control) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974, and this Order and the Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973, may be cited together as the Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Orders, 1973 and 1974.

2. Paragraph 4 of the Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973 and the Fuel (Control) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974, are hereby revoked.



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Order removes the prohibition imposed by the Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973, against the refusal by a supplier of motor fuel by retail to supply any person with motor fuel directly into the fuel tank of a motor vehicle. This follows the relaxation of the control of allocations of motor fuel to suppliers of motor fuel by retail under the scheme operated under the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act, 1973, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey.
