The Health and Safety at Work (Dangerous Substances)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1995

Made 9th March, 1995

Coming into operation 9th March, 1995

THE STATES BOARD OF EMPLOYMENT, INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 36 (1) (e) of the Health and Safety at Work (General) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1987, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Dangerous Substances

1. For the purposes of paragraphs 13 (2) (a) and 14 (2) of Part I of Schedule 2 to the Health and Safety at Work (General) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1987, the substances specified in the Schedule to these Regulations are hereby deemed to be "dangerous substances" and (for the purposes of the said paragraph 14 (2)) dangerous for conveyance.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as if they were an enactment.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health and Safety at Work (Dangerous Substances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1995.

Commencement

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 9th day of March, 1995.
