The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993

Made 27 May, 1993

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 1 June, 1993

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In Regulation 1 of the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990, as amended(b), hereafter referred to as "the principal Regulations", immediately before the definition of "non-business day" insert the following:-

"accounting period" means, in relation to items of pharmaceutical benefit and Part I and Part II appliances supplied by an authorised supplier or authorised appliance supplier, the period of one calendar month;"

2. In the definition of "specified percentage" in Regulation 1 of the principal Regulations, immediately following the words "first column of" insert the words "Part I of".

3. For sub-paragraph (1)(b) of Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations, substitute the following:-

"(b) the product of the specified percentage, in respect of that class of authorised supplier, and the amount of the basic price; provided that the sum of the products for all items of pharmaceutical benefit and the products for all Part I and Part II appliances payable under the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Appliance Suppliers) Regulations, 1990 supplied by that authorised supplier during the accounting period shall not exceed the amount specified in Part II of the First Schedule to these Regulations."

4. In sub-paragraph (1)(c)(i) of Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations delete the words from "(being a period ..." to "... 1990)".

5. For the First Schedule to the principal Regulations substitute the Schedule to these Regulations.

6. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993.



Regulations 1 and 2

PART I

Specified percentage payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit in accordance with Regulation 2(1)(b) of these Regulations.

Classes of authorised supplier	Specified percentage
A Dentist	Zero per centum
Medical Practitioner	Zero per centum
A Pharmacist:	
(a) employed by a medical practice	Zero per centum
(b) not employed by a medical practice and who supplies pharmaceutical benefit in Guernsey	5.0 per centum
(c) not employed by a medical practice and who supplies Pharmaceutical benefit in Alderney	12.0 per centum

PART II

Specified amount which shall not be exceeded in accordance with Regulation 2(1)(b) of these Regulations.

Classes of authorised supplier	Specified amount
A pharmacist not employed by a medical practice	£1,000.00

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990, as amended, by placing an upper limit on the amount of on-cost of the basic price of drugs payable to pharmacists who supply pharmaceutical benefit during an accounting period.
