

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2002 NO. 9THE R W RANDALL LTD DUTY FREE WAREHOUSE ORDER 2002

Made: 28th June 2002

Coming into operation: 28th June 2002

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Section 21 and Section 41(1) of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended (hereinafter called "the Law");

hereby orders:-

1. Stocks of duty free goods must be kept in premises approved by the Board (such premises being hereinafter described as an "approved warehouse").
2. When goods are brought to an approved warehouse for warehousing their proprietor shall make entry to the proper officer of Customs and Excise in such form and manner as the Board may direct.
3. Stock records must be kept to the satisfaction of the Chief Officer of Customs and Excise.
4. All goods imported into an approved warehouse must be accounted for to the satisfaction of the Board.
5. If at any time any dutiable goods entered to an approved warehouse cannot be accounted for as being subsequently entered for home use, or in stock, the import on such goods shall be paid immediately.
6. A Bankers Guarantee in favour of the States of Guernsey, in an amount sufficient to provide for the potential excise duty liability of the whole of the stock of an approved warehouse, must be provided in such form and amount as the Board

may from time to time require, provided that the Board may in its absolute discretion require any other form or manner of security in respect of the said liability, whether in addition to or in substitution for the said guarantee.

7. The Board hereby approves and appoints, for use as an approved warehouse for the purpose of the Law and this Order, the following premises, that is to say those premises as approved by the Chief Officer of Customs and Excise, at R W Randall Ltd, Vauxlaurens Brewery, St Julian's Avenue, St Peter Port, Guernsey. Provided that the said premises are managed and controlled by R W Randall Ltd and the said R W Randall Ltd shall, in relation to the said premises and all transactions conducted therefrom, ensure that the provisions of this Order and of the Law are complied with in all respects.

In the event of any contravention or non-compliance with any such provision whether by the said R W Randall Ltd or by any person whomsoever, the approval and appointment contained in this section may be terminated forthwith by the Board.

8. This Order may be cited as the R W Randall Ltd Duty Free Warehouse Order 2002.
9. This Order shall come into force on 28th June 2002.
10. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Statutory Instrument is made under sections 21 and 41(l) of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended.

It authorises R W Randall Limited to operate, subject to adequate provisions of security and under certain conditions laid down by the Chief Officer, Customs and Excise, a warehouse for the storage of duty free spirits at Vauxlaurens Brewery.
