The Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)
(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1982

Made 5th March, 1982
Laid before the States
Coming into Operation 5th March, 1982

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twenty-three of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended, (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation six of the principal regulations

1. Paragraph (3) of regulation six of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978(b), as amended (c), is hereby amended as follows:-

for the full stop at the end thereof there shall be substituted a colon and the following Proviso:-

"Provided that this provision shall not apply in any week where the employment available to that person is less than twenty hours."

Repeal

2. Paragraph (2) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Law, 1981 (d), is hereby repealed.

Citation and collective title

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1982.

(2) These regulations, the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1981 (e), and the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 and 1979 (f), may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 to 1982.

Commencement

4. These regulations shall come into force on the fifth day of March nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

Regulation one amends paragraph (3) of regulation six of the principal regulations so that a day on which any person is not normally employed shall nevertheless be regarded as a day of unemployment if the employment available to that person in any week is less than twenty hours.
