The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 2004

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 1 and 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended¹, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-
