GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 1998

Made 14th December, 1998

Laid before the States 1999

Coming into operation 1st April, 1999

THE STATES TOURIST BOARD, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist Law 1948(a) as amended(b), hereby orders:-

Fee payable by holder of boarding permit

1. The holder of a boarding permit shall pay to the Board, within 14 days of the granting of the permit -

- (a) in the case of premises classified by the Board under section 13 of the Law as a guest house, a fee of £2.35 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant to section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward;

- (b) in any other case, a fee of £3.80 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant to section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward.

Interpretation

2. In the Order "the Law" means the Tourist Law 1948 as amended, and expressions used in both the Law and this Order have the same meanings as in the Law.


Citation

3. This Order may be cited as the Boarding Permit Fees Order, 1998.

Commencement

4. This Order shall come into force on 1st April, 1999.
