The Fuel (Control) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974

Made 30th January, 1974

Coming into operation ... 30th January, 1974

The States of Guernsey Emergency Council, as respects the Bailiwick of Guernsey excluding the Island of Alderney, and the States of Alderney Finance Committee, as respects the Island of Alderney, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them respectively by subsection (1) of section two and section three of the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act 1973, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Fuel and Electricity (Control) Act 1973 (Guernsey) Order 1973, and of all other powers enabling them respectively in that behalf, hereby order:-

1.(1) This Order may be cited as the Fuel (Control) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1974, and this Order and the Fuel Control (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973(a), may be cited together as the Fuel (Control) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Orders, 1973 and 1974.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the thirtieth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.

2. The proviso to paragraph four of the Fuel Control (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973, is hereby revoked and the following proviso is hereby substituted therefor:-

Provided that the supplier shall not be required by virtue of this paragraph to supply motor fuel -

- (a) on any day in respect of any motor vehicle in excess of one gallon; or
- (b) in any event, where it appears to the supplier that

the fuel tank of the motor vehicle is half-full or more than half-full; or

- (c) on any Tuesday or Thursday between the hours of eight o'clock in the forenoon and noon."
