**The Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit)
(Amendment) Regulations, 1995**

Made 23rd February 1995
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 1st April 1995

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 35 and 38 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended(a), and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In Regulation 6 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, as amended(b), after "travel" insert -

"or prophylaxis against Malaria for the purpose of holiday or business travel."

Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 1990, as amended, so as to exempt prophylaxis against Malaria for the purpose of holiday or business travel from being a "medicinal purpose" for which pharmaceutical benefit can be supplied.
