IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946  
THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1978 -  
AMENDMENT TO THE OPEN GENERAL EXPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978, dated the 14 March, 1978 (a), the exportation from Guernsey of goods consigned to a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the Board of Administration.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises:-

1. In Article 1 of the Open General Export Licence made by the States Board of Administration, dated the tenth day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty (b), the reference to Iran shall be omitted.
2. This amendment shall take effect on the twenty eighth day of January nineteen hundred and eighty one.
