## GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT No. 4

**THE PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS ORDER (AMENDMENT), 2005**

Made 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2005  
Coming into force 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2005

**THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended<sup>1</sup>, hereby orders:-

**Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.**

1. In Part IX of Schedule 2 of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, for the entry relating to Paragraph 9 of Part IX substitute the following entry:-

“North to South, except for cyclists travelling in the cycle lane.”

**Citation.**

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2005.

**Commencement.**

3. This Order shall come into force on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2005.
