**GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT**

THE PROHIBITION OF IMPORT (MEAT, ANIMAL FEED ETC) ORDER, 2001

Made	22 February 2001
Laid before the States	2001
Coming into force	22 February 2001

The States Agriculture and Countryside Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 11 of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, as amended (a) and Section 4 the Importation of Hay, Straw and Litter Ordinance, 1950, as amended (b), hereby orders:

1. (1) The importation into the Island from the United Kingdom of any carcase of an animal and fertilisers and animal feedingstuffs that contain meat or bonemeal from an animal is prohibited.  
  
(2) The prohibition in Section 1 shall not apply to a carcase or fertilisers or feedingstuffs processed prior to 1 February 2001.
2. The importation into the Island of hay, straw and litter from the United Kingdom is prohibited.
3. In this Order the following meanings shall apply:  
  
“Animal” means cattle, sheep, goats and all other ruminating animals, swine and horses;  
  
“Carcase” means the carcase of any animal or any part thereof;  
  
“Feedingstuffs” means bone flour, bone meal, meat meal, dried blood, greaves and similar feedingstuffs of animal origin and compound feedingstuffs containing any such animal products.  
  
“Fertiliser” means hair, bones, bone meal, bone flour, meat meal, hooves, hoof meal, hoof shavings, horns, horn meal, horn shavings, greaves, tankage, blood, dried blood, blood meal and similar fertilisers of animal origin, and compound fertilisers containing any such animal products.

“Hay and straw” includes chaffed hay and chaffed straw and hay and straw chaffed together

“Island” means the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

“Litter” means straw or other substance commonly used for bedding or otherwise for or about animals

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (c) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Import (Meat, Animal Feed etc) Order, 2001
5. This Order shall come into force on 22 February 2001.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

This Order prohibits the importation of animal carcasses, fertilisers and animal feedingstuffs, hay, straw and litter from the United Kingdom.

These measures are introduced as a precautionary measure following an outbreak of Foot and Mouth disease in the United Kingdom.
