**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 63 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended<sup>a</sup>, and of all the powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

**Amendment**

1. In the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended<sup>b</sup>:

(a) in columns (2) and (3) of paragraph 2, for the words “twenty-one days” there is substituted “three months”;

(b) in column (2)(a) and (b) of paragraph 5, for the words “one month” there is substituted “three months”.

2. These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

These regulations increase the prescribed time for claiming sickness benefit, and for an increase of any benefit for a dependant, to three months.
