**The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2003**

**THE STATES TOURIST BOARD**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>a</sup>, as amended<sup>b</sup> and all other powers enabling it, hereby orders: -

**Fee payable by holder of a boarding permit.**

1. (1) The holder of a boarding permit shall pay to the Board -
  - (a) within 14 days of the granting of the permit a fee in the following amount -
    - (i) in the case of premises classified by the Board under section 13 of the Law as guest accommodation, a fee of £2.90 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant to

section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward; or

- (ii) in any other case, a fee of £4.65 multiplied by the maximum number of persons for whom the holder of the permit is permitted, in accordance with the condition attached to it pursuant to section 5(2) of the Law, to provide sleeping accommodation for reward; and

- (b) at any time a fee in an amount equivalent to the amount of any costs incurred by the Board, or any person acting on its behalf, for any purposes connected with the taking into account of any matters required for the classification and grading of premises to which the permit relates in accordance with section 13 of the Law.

### Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order, “**the Law**” means the Tourist (Guernsey) Law, 1948.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>c</sup> apply to the interpretation of this Order as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment.

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, references in this Order to an enactment are references thereto as amended, re-enacted (with or

without modification), extended or applied.

**Repeal.**

3. The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2001 is repealed<sup>d</sup>.


**Citation.**

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EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prescribes the fees payable by the holder of a boarding permit from 1 April 2003 and replaces the Boarding Fees Permit Order, 2001.
