The Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1998

Made	14th July, 1998.
Coming into effect	1st August, 1998.

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE, in exercise of its powers under Section 2 of The Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966 and The States Committees (Transfer of Functions) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1997, have made the following regulations:—

Amendment to 1986 Regulations

1. After Regulation 15 of The Traffic Regulations 1986, as amended, insert the following Regulation:

St. Anne's Church Car Park

15A. A person shall not, at the St. Anne's Church Car Park, permit a vehicle to remain parked for more than 23 hours in one continuous period.

Citation.

2. These regulations may be cited as The Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1998.

Commencement.

3. These Regulations come into force on the 1st day of August, 1998.
