

THE COMMERCE AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 8(1) of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance 1958 (a), as amended (b), hereby orders:-

1. The Milk (Retail Prices)(Guernsey)(Revocation) Order, 2005 (c) is hereby revoked and, therefore, for the avoidance of doubt, the Milk (Retail Prices)(Guernsey) Order, 2004 (d) shall remain in force as though the Milk (Retail Prices)(Guernsey) Order, 2005 had never been made.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (e) applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as The Milk (Retail Prices)(Guernsey)(Revocation)(No.2) Order, 2005.
4. This Order shall come into force on 18th October 2005.
