The Parking Places Order, 1991

Made 15th November, 1991

Coming into force 25th November, 1991

THE STATES ISLAND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 1, 4A and 6A of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

1. The areas and parts specified in the third column of Schedule 1 of the public highways specified in the second column of that Schedule are designated disc parking places and are referred to in this Order by the numbers assigned to them in the first column of that Schedule.

2. The areas and parts specified in the third column of Schedule 2 of the public highways specified in the second column of that Schedule are designated approved parking places and are referred to in this Order by the numbers assigned to them in the first column of that Schedule.

3. A person shall not park a vehicle in any approved parking place in Part B of Schedule 2.

4. A person shall not park a motor bicycle in any disc parking place.

5. A person shall not park -

(a) a vehicle in any part of disc parking place DC6, DC7, DE30 or DE31; or

(b) a motor bicycle in any part of approved parking place AB2 or AB3,

which, by order of the Harbour Master, is being used, or is required for use, in connection with any vessel.

6. A person shall not park a public vehicle in any disc parking place or approved parking place unless it is -

(a) a bus parked in an approved parking place in Part E of Schedule 2; or

(b) a taxi parked in an approved parking place in Part D of Schedule 2 for purposes of standing or plying for hire; or

(c) a taxi parked on the west side of the area of the road comprised in approved parking place AD6 for no longer than 1 hour; or

(d) a taxi or private hire motor car parked in a disc parking place, or in any approved parking place in Part A of Schedule 2, and not standing or plying for hire.

7.(1) A person shall not cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in a disc parking place or approved parking place in the course of a business of letting on hire, repairing or dealing in vehicles.

(2) A person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a goods vehicle which weighs 1.5 tons or more unladen or is more than six feet wide in any disc parking place or approved parking place (except for loading or unloading) between 18.00 on any day and 08.00 on

the next day following or on a Sunday or a Bank Holiday at any time.

8.(1) A person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a motor bicycle or a vehicle in any approved parking place in Part D of Schedule 2 unless it is a taxi and (subject to Article 6.(c)) is standing or plying for hire.

(2) A person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a vehicle or a motor bicycle in any of approved parking places AA78, AA79 or AA80, or on any part of a disc parking place or an approved parking place marked out by the Committee for loading or unloading, between 08.00 and 18.00 on any day except a Sunday or Bank Holiday (except for loading or unloading).

(3) A person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a motor bicycle or a vehicle other than a bus in any approved parking place in Part E of Schedule 2.

9. Subject to Article 13, a person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a vehicle -

- (a) in any disc parking place in Part A of Schedule 1 for a continuous period greater than 30 minutes ending between 08.00 and 18.00;
- (b) in any disc parking place in Part B of Schedule 1 for a continuous period greater than 1 hour ending between 08.00 and 18.00;
- (c) in any disc parking place in Part C of Schedule 1 for a continuous period greater than 2 hours ending between 08.00 and 18.00;

- (d) in any disc parking place in Part D of Schedule 1 for a continuous period greater than 5 hours ending between 08.00 and 18.00;
- (e) in any disc parking place in Part E of Schedule 1 for a continuous period greater than 10 hours ending between 08.00 and 18.00;
- (f) in any disc parking place in Part F of Schedule 1 except -
 - (i) between 06.00 and 08.00, while delivering or collecting at the market in a goods vehicle;
 - (ii) for a continuous period not greater than 30 minutes ending between 08.00 and the time at which the Public Markets are closed for business;
 - (iii) when the Public Markets are not open for business for a continuous period not greater than 12 hours;
- (g) in any disc parking place in Part G of Schedule 1 -
 - (i) between 06.00 and 10.00 except, for a continuous period not greater than 30 minutes, for the purpose of delivering to or collecting from trade premises for trade purposes; or
 - (ii) for a continuous period greater than 30 minutes ending between 10.00 and 18.00.

10. A person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a vehicle or a motor bicycle in any approved parking place in Part A of Schedule 2 between midnight of any day and midnight of the next day for a continuous period greater than 23 hours.

11. A person shall not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, park a motor bicycle in any approved parking place in Part B of Schedule 2 between midnight of any day and midnight of the next day for a continuous period greater than 23 hours.

12. A person shall not park a vehicle or motor bicycle -

(a) in approved parking place AC2 or AC8 at any time, without the permission in writing of the Committee, or

(b) in approved parking place AC1 between 08.00 and 17.00, or in approved parking place AC6 or AC7 between 08.00 and 18.00, on any day other than a Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday, without the permission in writing of the Committee, or

(c) in approved parking place AC3, AC4 or AC5 at any time, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police,

except for the purpose indicated in respect of that approved parking place by the signs referred to in the third column of Part C of Schedule 2

13. Notwithstanding Article 9, a person may park a vehicle in any disc parking place for any length of time -

- (a) between 18.00 on a Saturday and 08.00 on the next following Monday; and/or
- (b) between 18.00 on the day preceding a Bank Holiday and 08.00 on the day after the Bank Holiday.

14. A person shall not park a vehicle or motor bicycle in any disc parking place or approved parking place except in the manner indicated by any parking signs and/or white lines marked by the Committee.

15. A person who parks a vehicle in a disc parking place or approved parking place must park it as close as is reasonably practicable to any other vehicle parked therein.

16. A person who parks a vehicle in a disc parking place or approved parking place for a single line of vehicles adjacent to a kerb or the edge of a carriageway must park it as close as is reasonably practicable to that kerb or the edge of that carriageway, as the case may be.

17. A person in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle which is parked in a disc parking place or approved parking place must move it within, or remove it from, that parking place on being requested to do so by any person having reasonable grounds for making such a request or by an officer of police.

18. A person in charge of a vehicle which has been parked in a disc parking place:-

- (a) must remove that vehicle from that disc parking place before the expiry of the permitted period; and
- (b) must not, without the permission in writing of the Committee, re-park that vehicle in that disc parking place until a period of 30 minutes

has expired.

19.(1) In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires:-

"Bank Holiday" means a day approved as a Bank Holiday by Ordinance;

"bus" means a vehicle in respect of which a public service omnibus licence is in force;

"disabled person's badge" means a badge issued to a disabled or blind person by the Committee, or a badge recognised by the Committee as a badge issued to a disabled or blind person by a competent authority in a country or territory subscribing to the reciprocal parking arrangements for disabled and blind people in Europe;

"goods vehicle" means any vehicle which is designed or constructed for use, or which is being used, wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods;

"numbers" includes letters and numerals;

"officer of police" means a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey and, within the limits of his jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary of the Island of Guernsey;

"the Ordinance of 1986" means the Public Transport Ordinance, 1986(b);

"private hire motor car" means a vehicle in respect of which a private hire motor car licence is in force;

"private hire motor car licence" has the meaning assigned by section 57 of the Ordinance of 1986;

"public service omnibus licence" has the meaning assigned by section 57 of the Ordinance of 1986;

"public vehicle" means a vehicle which is used for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward and which is offered for use either by standing or plying for hire or which is so offered in any other way whatsoever;

"taxi" mean a vehicle in respect of which a taxi licence is in force;

"taxi licence" has the meaning assigned by section 57 of the Ordinance of 1986;

and other expressions have the same meanings as in the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963.

(2) Unless the context otherwise requires, a reference in this Order to a numbered provision or Schedule is to the provision of or Schedule to this Order which is so numbered.

(3) Any reference in this Order to any other enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment.

(4) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(c), applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

20. The Orders set out in Schedule 3 are repealed.

21. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places Order, 1991.

22. This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of November, 1991.
