The Boats (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1991

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1(3) of the Hired Boats and Passenger Boats (Guernsey) Law, 1988(a) hereby make the following Regulations:-

Exemption for approved water taxis.

1. In the Boats (Guernsey) Regulations, 1990(b) -

(a) immediately after the definition of "the Law" in regulation 1.1 insert:

"water taxi service" means an arrangement under which people are transported by water from land to boat, from boat to land, or from boat to boat.";

(b) immediately after regulation 6.1 insert:

" 6.2 Section 1 of the Law does not apply to the carriage of a person

within half a nautical mile of the south eastern extremity of the White Rock Pier by a water taxi service which is for the time being approved in writing by the Board, and in accordance with any conditions subject to which that approval is given."


2.1 These Regulations may be cited as the Boats (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1991.

2.2 These Regulations and the Boats (Guernsey) Regulations, 1990 may be cited together as the Boats (Guernsey) Regulations, 1990 and 1991.

Commencement.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on 31st December, 1991.
