The Imported Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1974.

THE STATES DAIRY COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section eight of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. During the period commencing on the eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, the price to be charged on a sale by retail of milk which has not been produced in this Island shall be at the rate of nine new pence per pint:

Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to any milk supplied to a beneficiary under any scheme for the time being in force provided by the States for the supply of milk whether free of cost or at a reduced price.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Imported Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1974, and shall come into force on the eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
