**The Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (No. 2) (Guernsey)  
Order, 2011**

**THE HOME DEPARTMENT**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 33(1) of the Immigration Act 1971<sup>a</sup> as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1993<sup>b</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:-

**Fee for work permit.**

1. The fee to be paid by an employer for the issue of a work permit is set out in the Schedule.

**Revocation of Order of 2011.**

2. The Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (Guernsey) Order, 2011<sup>c</sup> is revoked.

**Transitional provisions.**

3. (1) The fee prescribed by article 1 does not apply in relation to the

issue of a replacement permit in any of the following circumstances –

- (a) where an application for the replacement permit was made to the Home Department before the commencement date,
- (b) where a replacement permit is necessary because the work permit was lost or stolen before the commencement date, or
- (c) where a replacement permit is necessary as a result of the employer providing incorrect information to the Department before the commencement date.

(2) The fee for the issue of a replacement permit in any of the circumstances described in paragraph (1) is to be determined as if –

- (a) this Order had not come into force, and
- (b) the Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (Guernsey) Order, 2011 had not been revoked.

(3) In this article, "**commencement date**" means the date specified in article 5 for this Order to come into force.

**Citation.**

4. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Order, 2011.

**Commencement.**

5. This Order comes into force on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November, 2011.

**FEE FOR WORK PERMIT**

<b>Type of permit</b>	<b>Specific issue</b>	<b>Fee</b>
Where the Home Department is satisfied that the person named in the permit is to be employed for one month or less.	First issue of the permit	£50
	Issue of replacement permit, in any case where the work permit is reported as lost or stolen or where a replacement permit is necessary as a result of the employer providing incorrect information to the Department	£20
Where the Home Department is <i>not</i> satisfied that the person named in the permit is to be employed for one month or less.	First issue of the permit	£300
	Issue of replacement permit, in any case where the work permit is reported as lost or stolen or where a replacement permit is necessary as a result of the employer providing incorrect information to the Department	£100

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order sets out various fees to be paid by an employer for the issue of a work permit in respect of a non-European Economic Area national. This Order also sets out the fee to be paid in cases where a work permit is issued to replace a lost or stolen work permit or where a replacement permit is necessary as a result of the employer providing incorrect information.

This Order comes into force on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November, 2011.
