**The Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit)
(Amendment) Regulations, 2004**

Made 4th November 2004
Laid before the States
Coming into Operation 4th November 2004

THE SOCIAL SECURITY DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 10 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^a, section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited Lists) Ordinance, 2004^b and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

- 1. In the Schedule to the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) Regulations, 2004^c add the rows set out in the Schedule to these Regulations, under the appropriate headings.

Extent

- 2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

- 3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Limited List) (Pharmaceutical Benefit) (Amendment) Regulations, 2004

Commencement

- 4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 4th day of November 2004
