THE ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 2A and 2B of the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Fees payable in accordance with table.

1. The fee indicated in the second column of the table set out in the Schedule to these regulations shall be paid to the Department in respect of the event or matter indicated in the first column of the table.

Interpretation.

2. (1) Unless the context requires otherwise, expressions used in these Regulations shall have the same meaning as they have for the purposes of the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b applies to the interpretation of these Regulations.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation and commencement.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Fees) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2007 and shall come into force on the 1st January, 2008.



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made by the Environment Department under the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987. They prescribe the fees payable to the Department upon first registration of a motor vehicle (£35) and the issue of a duplicate registration certificate (£10). The fees are payable to the Department with effect from the 1st January 2008.
