Ordinance of the States. **XXXVIII**

Made 6th December, 1950
Coming into Operation 11th December, 1950

**The Aircraft Charges (Alderney Freight)
Exemption Ordinance, 1950.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 11th day of October, 1950, hereby order:—

1. Notwithstanding any of the provisions of the Ordinance directing the Scale of Charges Applicable to Aircraft, 1946, no charge shall be made thereunder—

(1) under the heading "Aircraft Fee" in either part of the Schedule thereto in respect of an aircraft carrying freight only between the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney, or travelling unloaded from the Island of Guernsey to the Island of Alderney in order to collect freight only in the latter Island;

(2) under the heading "Cargo Fee" in the first part of the said Schedule in respect of an air-

craft carrying freight only or carrying freight in excess of 499 pounds avoirdupois and passengers between the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.

2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 11th day of December, 1950, and shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.
