# Ordinance of the States **XXXIV**

## **The Aircraft Charges (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1957**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and of the powers vested in them by paragraph (3) of Article seven of the Air Navigation (Guernsey) Order, 1926, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section two thereof, the words “three shillings and eleven pence” are hereby deleted and the words “four shillings and eight pence” substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section two thereof, the words “two shillings and

six pence ” are hereby deleted and the words “two shillings and ten pence ” substituted therefor;

- (c) in subsection (2) of section five thereof, the words “two shillings ” are hereby deleted and the words “two shillings and four pence ” substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Aircraft Charges (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1957, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1956 and 1957.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
