**The Aircraft Charges (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and of the powers vested in them by paragraph (3) of Article seven of the Air Navigation (Guernsey) Order, 1926, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1956, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows—

- (a) in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section two thereof the words “four shillings and eight pence” are hereby deleted and the words “five shillings and two pence” substituted therefor;

- (b) in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section two thereof the words "three shillings and three pence" are hereby deleted and the words "five shillings and two pence" substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section two thereof the words "two shillings and ten pence" are hereby deleted and the words "three shillings and one penny" substituted therefor.

2. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of section one of the Aircraft Charges (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1957, are hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Aircraft Charges (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, and this Ordinance and the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1956 and 1957, may be cited together as the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1956 to 1958.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
