**The Aircraft Charges (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1963.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of February, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and in exercise of the powers now vested in them under paragraph (3) of Article seven of the Air Navigation (Guernsey) Order, 1926(a), and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. The Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1956(b), as amended(c), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:—

- (a) in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section two thereof, the words "five shillings and two pence" are hereby repealed and the words "five shillings and eleven pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section two thereof, the words "five shillings and two pence" are hereby repealed and the words "five shillings and eleven pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section two thereof, the words "three shillings and one penny" are hereby repealed and the words "three shillings and six pence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (d) in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section two thereof, the words "one shilling and ten pence" are hereby repealed and the words "two shillings and one penny" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (e) in paragraph (a) of section four thereof, the words "thirty-three and one-third per centum" are hereby repealed and the words "forty-two per centum" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (f) in paragraph (b) of section four thereof, the words "sixty-six and two thirds per centum" are hereby repealed and the words "seventy-one per centum" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (g) in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section five thereof, the words "fifty per centum" are hereby repealed and the words "fifty-seven per centum" are hereby substituted therefor;

- (h) in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section five thereof, the words "seventy-five per centum" are hereby repealed and the words "seventy-eight per centum" are hereby substituted therefor.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the principal Ordinance, instead of the fees payable by the Operator in pursuance of those provisions in respect of each departure of any aircraft from the Guernsey Airport to the Alderney Airport and in respect of each arrival of any aircraft at the Guernsey Airport from the Alderney Airport, there shall be paid by the Operator—

Annual sum to be paid by Airlines (Jersey) Limited, as respects the Guernsey Airport, in respect of aircraft departing to or arriving from the Alderney Airport.

- (a) as respects the year nineteen hundred and sixty-three, a sum equal to the difference between the sum of two thousand three hundred pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the Operator in pursuance of those provisions before the commencement of this Ordinance in respect of any such departure and of any such arrival during the year nineteen hundred and sixty-three;
- (b) as respects each of the years nineteen hundred and sixty-four and nineteen hundred and sixty-five, the sum of two thousand three hundred pounds.

(2) The sum payable in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section as respects any year shall be paid in such manner and by such instalments, whether in advance or in arrear, as the States Board of Administration may from time to time direct.

(3) For the purposes of this section—

- (a) the expression "the Operator" means the company known as Airlines (Jersey)

Limited, whose registered office is situate at Alares House, The Airport, in the parish of Saint Peter, in the Island of Jersey;

- (b) the expression "the principal Ordinance" means the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1956, as amended by any enactment including this Ordinance.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Aircraft Charges (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1963, and this Ordinance, the Aircraft Charges (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959, and the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1956 to 1958, may be cited together as the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinances, 1956 to 1963.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
