**The Aircraft Charges (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1959**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the ninth day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, and of the powers now vested in them under paragraph (3) of Article seven of the Air Navigation (Guernsey) Order, 1926, and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Aircraft Charges (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") instead of the fees payable in pursuance of the principal Ordinance, as respects the Alderney Airport, there shall, on and after the coming into force of this Ordinance, be paid by the Operator an annual amount which shall be an amount equal to the yearly average of the amounts which would have

been paid by the Operator during the years nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight and nineteen hundred and fifty-nine in pursuance of the provisions of the principal Ordinance if the fees during those three years had been at the rates in force immediately prior to the coming into force of this Ordinance.

(2) The annual amount payable in pursuance of the provisions of the last preceding subsection shall be paid in such manner and by such instalments, whether in advance or in arrear, as the States Board of Administration may from time to time direct.

(3) On and after the coming into force of this Ordinance, as respects the Alderney Airport, the Operator shall not be entitled to a refund in pursuance of the provisions of section three of the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of "standard rate" and "particular rate" for purposes of refund.

2. In calculating the "standard rate" and the "particular rate" for the purposes of section three of the principal Ordinance, no account shall be taken of the number of passengers landed from or of passengers embarked in passenger aircraft at the Airport who arrive from or depart for a place which is not more than fifty-five nautical miles from the Guernsey Airport.

Amendments to principal Ordinance.

3. In subsection (1) and subsection (2) of section two of the principal Ordinance the word "destination" where that word occurs in those subsections is hereby deleted and the word "place" substituted therefor.

Interpretation.

4. For the purposes of this Ordinance the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:—

“the Airport” means—

- (a) as respects the Island of Guernsey, the Guernsey Airport; and
- (b) as respects the Island of Alderney, the Alderney Airport;

“the Operator” means the company known as Airlines (Jersey) Limited whose registered office is situate at Alares House, The Airport, in the parish of Saint Peter, in the Island of Jersey.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty. Commence-
ment.
