Ordinance of the States. **VII**

1954

Made 2nd June, 1954.

Came into Operation 28th April, 1954.

The Aircraft Charges (Temporary Amendment) Ordinance, 1954.

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of April, 1954, and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them under paragraph (3) of Article seven of the Air Navigation (Guernsey) Order, 1926, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Part I of the Schedule to the Ordinance Directing a Scale of Charges Applicable to Aircraft, 1946 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance) as amended and as extended to Alderney, shall, during the period which this Ordinance is in force, be further amended as follows:—

- (a) in paragraphs A, C, D and E of the said Part of the said Schedule for the words "To or from a destination outside the Channel Islands" where those words occur in the left-hand columns of the said paragraphs there shall be substituted the words "To or from a place situate more than thirty miles from the Airport in the Bailiwick from or to which the

aircraft departs or arrives" and in the said paragraphs for the words "To or from a destination within the Channel Islands" where those words occur in the said columns there shall be substituted the words "To or from a place situate not more than thirty miles from the Airport in the Bailiwick from or to which the aircraft departs or arrives";

- (b) in paragraph D of the said Part of the said Schedule for the words and figures "6d. for each 25 lb. or part" where they occur in the right-hand column of that paragraph there shall be substituted the words and figures "4½d. for each 25 lbs. or part thereof of a cargo not exceeding 1,000 lbs. and thereafter 1d. for each 25 lbs. or part thereof of such cargo" and for the words and figures "3d. for each 25 lb or part" where they occur in the said column there shall be substituted the words and figures "3d. for each 25 lbs. or part thereof of a cargo not exceeding 1,000 lbs. and thereafter 1d. for each 25 lbs. or part thereof of such cargo."

2. Paragraph F of Part 1 of the Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the 28th day of April, 1954, and shall, other than the provisions of section two thereof, cease to have effect on the 27th day of April, 1955.
