The Airport (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. The Airport Ordinance, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance")^(a), is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) in section fifteen thereof the marginal note thereto is repealed and the following marginal note is substituted therefor—

"Trespassing by persons.";

(b) immediately after section fifteen thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered "15A"—

"Trespassing by animals.

15A. (1) If any animal trespasses on the Airport, the owner of such animal or the person in charge of such animal or both such owner and such person shall

be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.

(2) If any animal trespasses on the Airport, the Commandant, or a member of the Airport Staff, acting on general or specific instructions of the Commandant, may, without prejudice to any proceedings under the provisions of the last preceding subsection consequent upon such trespass, remove such animal and detain it in any place and the cost of taking such action shall be recoverable by the States from the owner of such animal as a civil debt."

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Airport (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.

Collective title.

3. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Airport Ordinances, 1950 and 1974.
