**The Airport Fees (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the twenty-sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, and of the thirtieth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the Airport Fees Ordinance, 1968 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance")(a), instead of the fees payable by the Operator in pursuance of those provisions in respect of each departure from the Guernsey Airport to the Jersey Airport and in respect of each arrival at the Guernsey Airport from the Jersey Airport, there shall be paid by the Opera-

tor, as respects the year nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, an amount equal to the difference between the sum of seven thousand and one hundred pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the Operator in pursuance of those provisions before the coming into force of this Ordinance in respect of such departures and of such arrivals during the said year.

(2) The amount payable in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be paid in such manner and by such instalments, whether in advance or in arrear, as the States Board of Administration may direct.

(3) In this section the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

“the Guernsey Airport” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section twelve of the principal Ordinance;

“the Jersey Airport” means the premises for the time being used in the Island of Jersey for the landing and departure of aircraft or for purposes ancillary thereto;

“the Operator” means the company known as Aurigny Air Services Limited whose registered office is situate at Bond Street Chambers in the parish of Saint Helier, in the Island of Jersey.

2. Section seven of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:—

“ 7. (1) There shall be payable by an operator who has been granted a Class A licence in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of 1960 to operate an air transport service:—

- (a) between the Island of Alderney and a place outside a radius of fifty-five nautical miles from the Airport, instead of any fee otherwise payable in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance as respects the Alderney Airport, a fee, as respects the year nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, of four thousand and eighty-eight pounds;
- (b) between the Island of Alderney and a place within a radius of fifty-five nautical miles from the Airport, instead of any fee otherwise payable in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance as respects the Alderney Airport, a fee, as respects the year nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, of one thousand four hundred and thirty-six pounds.

(2) There shall be payable, as respects each year after the year nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, by an operator who has been granted a Class A licence in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of 1960 to operate an air transport service between the Island of Alderney and a place outside or inside a radius of fifty-five nautical miles from the Airport instead of any fee otherwise payable in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance as respects the Alderney Airport, a fee which shall be in an amount which bears the same proportion to the sum of five thousand five hundred and twenty-four pounds as the aggregate of the fees which the operator would, but for the provisions of this subsection, have paid in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance in respect of the operation of such service as aforesaid in that year, bears to the aggregate of the fees which would, but for the provisions of this subsection, have been paid by all the operators in respect of the operation of such services as aforesaid in that year.

(3) In making any calculation for the purposes of the last preceding subsection any amount of less than one penny shall be disregarded.

(4) There shall be payable by an operator who has been granted a Class A licence in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of 1960 to operate an air transport service between the Island of Guernsey and the Island of Alderney in respect of each departure from the Guernsey Airport to the Alderney Airport and in respect of each arrival at the Guernsey Airport from the Alderney Airport, either:—

(a) a fee as respects each year, of two thousand four hundred and sixty pounds, or, if in any year an operator does not operate such an air transport service throughout that year, such proportion of that fee as the period of the year during which he provides such an air transport service bears to that year, any fraction of a month forming part of any such period being regarded as a complete month; or

(b) a fee equal to the aggregate of the appropriate fees payable in pursuance of the provisions of section one, section three or section four of this Ordinance, as the case may be, as respects that year or part thereof;

whichever is the lesser.

(5) The annual fee payable in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1), subsection (2) or paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of this section shall be paid in such manner and by such instalments, whether in advance or in arrear, as the Board may, from time to time, direct.”.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney. Extent.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Airport Fees (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Airport Fees Ordinances, 1968 and 1969. Citation and collective title.
