**The Airport Fees (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Airport Fees Ordinance, 1971 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance")(b), there shall be payable by the Operator in respect of each departure from the Guernsey Airport to the Jersey Airport and in respect of each arrival at the Guernsey Airport from the Jersey Airport of an aircraft, as respects the year nineteen hundred and seventy-two, either:—

Special fees for flights between Guernsey and Jersey Airports.

- (a) an amount equal to the difference between the sum of fourteen thousand one hundred

and twenty-five pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the Operator in pursuance of the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance in respect of such departures and of such arrivals during the said year; or

- (b) a fee equal to the aggregate of the appropriate fees payable in pursuance of the provisions of section one, section three or section four of the principal Ordinance, as the case may be, as respects the said year;

whichever is the lesser.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the principal Ordinance, there shall be payable by the Operator in respect of each departure from and each arrival at the Alderney Airport of an aircraft to or from a place outside or inside a radius of fifty-five miles from the Alderney Airport, as respects the year nineteen hundred and seventy-two, either:—

- (a) an amount equal to the difference between the sum of ten thousand four hundred and thirty-five pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the Operator in pursuance of the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance in respect of such departures and of such arrivals during the said year; or
- (b) a fee equal to the aggregate of the appropriate fees payable in pursuance of the provisions of section one, section three or section four of the principal Ordinance, as the case may be, as respects the said year;

whichever is the lesser.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the principal Ordinance, there shall be payable by the Operator in respect of each departure from the Guernsey Airport to the Alderney Airport and in respect of each arrival at the Guernsey Airport from the Alderney Airport of an aircraft, as respects the year nineteen hundred and seventy-two, either:—

Special fees for flights between Guernsey and Alderney Airports.

- (a) an amount equal to the difference between the sum of four thousand six hundred and eighty-seven pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the Operator in pursuance of the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance in respect of such departures and of such arrivals during the said year; or
- (b) a fee equal to the aggregate of the appropriate fees payable in pursuance of the provisions of section one, section three or section four of the principal Ordinance, as the case may be, as respects the said year;

whichever is the lesser.

4. Any amount payable in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (a) of section one, paragraph (a) of section two or paragraph (a) of section three of this Ordinance shall be paid in such manner and by such instalments, whether in advance or in arrear, as the States Board of Administration may, from time to time, direct.

Method of payment of fees.

5. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

Interpretation.

“the Alderney Airport” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section fourteen of the principal Ordinance;

“the Guernsey Airport” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section fourteen of the principal Ordinance;

“the Jersey Airport” means the premises for the time being used in the Island of Jersey for the landing and departure of aircraft or for purposes ancillary thereto;

“the Operator” means the company known as Aurigny Air Services Limited whose registered office is situate at Bond Street Chambers in the parish of Saint Helier, in the Island of Jersey.

- Repeal. 6. The Airport Fees (Amendment) Ordinance, 1971(c), is hereby repealed.
- Extent. 7. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.
- Construction. 8. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance shall be construed as one.
- Citation. 9. This Ordinance may be cited as the Airport Fees (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.
