The Airport Fees (Commutated) Ordinance, 1973

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Airport Fees Ordinance, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance")(b), there shall be payable by the Operator in respect of all arrivals at the Guernsey Airport of aircraft owned by the Operator, during the year nineteen hundred and seventy-three, either:—

Special fees for flights by the Operator to Guernsey Airport in 1973.

- (a) an amount equal to the difference between the sum of twenty-six thousand pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the

Operator in pursuance of the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance in respect of such arrivals during the said year; or

- (b) a fee equal to the aggregate of the appropriate fees payable in pursuance of the provisions of section one, section two, section three or section four of the principal Ordinance, as the case may be, as respects the said year;

whichever is the lesser.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the principal Ordinance, there shall be payable by the Operator in respect of all arrivals at the Alderney Airport of aircraft owned by the Operator, during the year nineteen hundred and seventy-three, either:—

- (a) an amount equal to the difference between the sum of fifteen thousand pounds and the total amount of any fees paid by the Operator in pursuance of the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance in respect of such arrivals during the said year; or

- (b) a fee equal to the aggregate of the appropriate fees payable in pursuance of the provisions of section one, section two, section three or section four of the principal Ordinance, as the case may be, as respects the said year;

whichever is the lesser.

3. Notwithstanding any of the provisions of any Ordinance for the time being in force prescribing the fees payable in respect of arrivals of aircraft at the Guernsey Airport and the Alderney Airport, there may be payable by the Operator in respect of all such arrivals of aircraft owned by the Operator during each year after the year nineteen hundred and seventy-three, a commuted fee of such amount as shall be agreed between the Board and the Operator and approved by Resolution of the States of Guernsey as respects each such year.

4. Any amount payable in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (a) of section one or paragraph (a) of section two of this Ordinance shall be paid in such manner and by such instalments, whether in advance or in arrea, as the Board may, from time to time, direct.

5. Any fee payable in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance may be recovered from the Operator as a civil debt due to the States of Guernsey.

6. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

Interpreta-
tion.

“the Alderney Airport” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section fifteen of the principal Ordinance;

“the Board” means the States Board of Administration;

“the Guernsey Airport” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section fifteen of the principal Ordinance;

“the Operator” means the company known as Aurigny Air Services Limited whose registered office is situate at Bond Street Chambers in the parish of Saint Helier, in the Island of Jersey;

“owned” includes chartered.

- Extent. 7. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.
- Construction. 8. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance shall be construed as one.
- Citation. 9. This Ordinance may be cited as the Airport Fees (Commuted) Ordinance, 1973.
