**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Adoption) Ordinance, 1979**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, as amended^(a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, hereby order:—

1. Sections one and five, subsections (2) and (3) of section nine and sections eleven, twelve and thirteen of the Adoption (Guernsey) Law, 1970^(b), and the Adoption (Designation of Overseas Adoptions) Ordinance, 1979^(c), shall, subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out respectively in Part I and Part II of the Schedule to this Ordinance, have effect in the Island of Alderney as they have effect in the Island of Guernsey.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Adoption) Ordinance, 1979.

SCHEDULE Section one
EXCEPTIONS, ADAPTATIONS AND
MODIFICATIONS

PART I

The Adoption (Guernsey) Law, 1970

1. In sections one, five, twelve and thirteen the words "the States", whenever those words occur, are deleted and the words "the States of Guernsey" are substituted therefor.

2. In subsection (1) of section one the definitions of the expressions "the Court", "the Island" and "the Law of 1960" are deleted and the following definitions are respectively substituted therefor—

“the Court” means the Royal Court of Guernsey sitting as an Ordinary Court;

“the Island” means the Island of Alderney;

“the Law of 1960” means the Adoption (Guernsey) Law, 1960, as extended by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Adoption) Ordinance, 1974;”.

3. Immediately after subsection (3) of section twelve there is inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(4)”—

“(4)” In this section the expression “the Royal Court” means the Royal Court of Guernsey sitting as a Full Court.”.

PART II

*The Adoption (Designation of Overseas Adoptions)
Ordinance, 1979*

1. Subsection (1) of section three is deleted and the following subsection is substituted therefor—

“(1) In this Ordinance, except where the context otherwise requires, the expression “the Law” means the Adoption (Guernsey) Law, 1970, as extended by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Adoption) Ordinance, 1979, and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.”.
