ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

1. 1956 Law to have effect in Alderney.
2. Commencement.

(Made on the 16th May, 1956.)

**The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Cadastre)
Ordinance, 1956**

THE STATES, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: –

1956 Law to have effect in Alderney.

1. The Cadastre (Amendment) Law, 1956, shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

NOTE

In accordance with the provisions of the Taxation of Real Property (Enabling Provisions) (Guernsey and Alderney) Law, 2005, section 4(c) and section 4(h), with effect from 13th November, 2006, this enactment is one of those that the States may repeal, amend, extend, adapt, modify or disapply by Ordinance made under the 2005 Law.

Commencement.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the 17th day of May, 1956.
