Ordinance of the States **XXXIX** 1973

Made 27th September, 1973.
Coming into Operation ... 1st November, 1973.

The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Document Duty) Ordinance, 1973

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Document Duty (Guernsey) Law, 1973(b), shall, subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out in the First Schedule to this Ordinance, have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey. Document Duty Law to have effect in Alderney.

2. The Ordinance set out in the left-hand column of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent set out in the right-hand column of the said Schedule. Repeal.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Document Duty) Ordinance, 1973.

Commencement. 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.

FIRST SCHEDULE Section one

Exceptions, adaptations and modifications

1. In section one and in section five the words "Her Majesty's Greffier", wherever those words occur, are deleted and the words "the Clerk of the Court of Alderney" are substituted therefor.

2. Subsection (1) of section seven is deleted and the following subsection is substituted therefor—

"(1) In this Law, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—

"the Cadastre" means the valuation carried out and maintained under the provisions of section four of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(c);

"Friendly Society" means a society registered under the Friendly Societies Act 1896;

"this Island" means the Island of Alderney;

"the Records of this Island" includes the "Registre des Sociétés établies avec responsabilité limitée" kept under the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Sociétés Anonymes ou à Responsabilité Limitée" registered on the twenty-second day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety-four(d) and the Alderney Land Register kept under the Alderney Land and Property, etc. Law, 1949(e);

"the States" means the States of Guernsey."
