Ordinance of the States **XXXIX**

1969

Made 17th December, 1969.
Coming into Operation 1st January, 1970.

**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Dog Licences) Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section two of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Dog Licences (Guernsey) Law, 1969, in its extension to the Island of Alderney by virtue of section two of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, shall have effect in the Island of Alderney subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Exceptions etc. subject to which the Dog Licences (Guernsey) Law, 1969, extends to Alderney.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Dog Licences) Ordinance, 1969.

Citation and commencement.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy.

SCHEDULE Section one

Exceptions, adaptations and modifications

1. Immediately after the words "the States", wherever they occur, there shall be inserted the words "of Guernsey".
2. In section three, for the words from and including the words "by a Constable" to the end of that section there shall be substituted the words and brackets "by the Treasurer of the States of Alderney (hereafter in this Law referred to as "the Treasurer")".
3. In subsection (1) of section five, for the words "the Constables of every parish" there shall be substituted the words "the Treasurer" and for the word "them" there shall be substituted the word "him".
4. Section six and section seven shall be omitted.
5. In section eight—
 - (a) paragraph (c) of subsection (1) thereof shall be omitted;
 - (b) in subsection (2) thereof, for the words "a Constable of the parish in which he has his ordinary place of residence" there shall be substituted the words "the Treasurer" and for the words "that Constable or" there shall be substituted the words "the Treasurer or by such".
6. In paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section nine, for the words from and including the words "and,

within the limits” to the end of that paragraph there shall be substituted the words “and a member of any police force which may be established by the States of Alderney”.

7. The Schedule shall be omitted.
