**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Education) Ordinance, 1958**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, and under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948, hereby order:—

1. In the second column of Part II of the First Schedule to the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948, there is hereby inserted immediately after the modification of section three of the Education Law (Guernsey), 1935 (as amended by the Education (Amendment) Law (Guernsey), 1938) the following additional modification, that is to say—

“In paragraph (b) of subsection (8) of section six the words and comma “Elizabeth College and to the Ladies’ College,” are hereby deleted and the words “Elizabeth College, the Ladies’ College

and to Blanchelande College” are hereby substituted therefor and the words and comma “Elizabeth College and the Ladies’ College,” are hereby deleted and the words “Elizabeth College, Ladies’ College and Blanchelande College” are hereby substituted therefor.”.

2. This Ordinance and the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinances, 1948 and 1951, may be cited together as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Education) Ordinances, 1948 to 1958.
