The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Education) Ordinance, 1970

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970(b), shall, subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out in the right hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance, have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

- Repeals. 2. The entries relating to the Education Law (Guernsey), 1935, contained in the first and second columns of Part II of the First Schedule to the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948(c), are hereby repealed.
- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Education) Ordinance, 1970.
- Commence-
ment. 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-eighth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy.

Law	Exceptions, adaptations and modifications
The Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970.	<p>In subsection (1) of section one—</p> <p>(a) the definitions of the expressions “authorised medical practitioner” and “authorised dentist” are hereby deleted and the following definitions are hereby substituted therefor—</p> <p>“ “authorised medical practitioner” and “authorised dentist” mean respectively a person practising in the Island as a medical practitioner or as a dentist and approved by the Council;”;</p> <p>(b) immediately after the word “Island” in the definition of the expression “Chief Officer of Police” there are hereby inserted the words “of Guernsey”;</p> <p>(c) in the definition of the expression “the Island” the word “Guernsey” is hereby deleted and the word “Alderney” is hereby substituted therefor;</p> <p>(d) immediately after the definition of the expression “registered school” there is hereby inserted the following additional definition—</p> <p>“ “the Royal Court” means the Royal Court of Guernsey sitting as a Full Court;”;</p> <p>(e) immediately after the definition of the expression “senior pupil” there is hereby inserted the following additional definition—</p>

“ “the States” means the States of Guernsey;”.

Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section four is hereby deleted.

In subsection (1) of section five the words “ or any parish or jointly by the States and any parish ” are hereby deleted.

Section six is hereby deleted and the following section is hereby substituted therefor—

“ 6. (1) There shall be a committee of management for Saint Anne’s School with authority to exercise the same powers and perform the same duties in relation to that school as are vested in the Primary Schools Committees and the Secondary Schools Committees in relation to States’ primary and secondary schools in Guernsey by the Education (Schools Committees) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) The States of Alderney shall, from time to time, by Resolution make provision as to the composition of the said committee of management, the mode of appointment or election, as the case may be, the term of office and the conditions of retirement of the members of the said committee and any such Resolution may provide for periodical or other meetings of the said committee and as to the procedure at such meetings, but, subject to the provisions of any such Resolution, the procedure of the said committee shall be determined by it.”.

In subsection (1) of section twenty-one the words “ Subject to the provisions of this section ” are hereby deleted.

Subsections (2), (3), (4), (5), (6) and (7) of section twenty-one are hereby deleted.
Section twenty-two is hereby deleted.

In subsection (4) of section forty-seven the words "the Bailiff" are hereby deleted and the words "the Chairman of the Court of Alderney" are hereby substituted therefor.
