The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) (Food Hygiene) Ordinance, 1975

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-seventh day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Food and Drugs (Food Hygiene) Ordinance, 1975(b), shall, subject to the adaptations and modifications set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance, have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey. Ordinance of 1975 to have effect in Alderney.
2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney Citation.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the Commence-

SCHEDULE Section one

Adaptations and Modifications

1. In subsection (2) of section thirty-one immediately after the words "Article sixteen of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Marchés Publics, aux Abattoirs et à la Vente de la Viande" of the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighteen" there are inserted the words "as extended by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948".

2. In paragraph 2 of the Second Schedule the expression "the States of Guernsey" shall be construed as including a reference to the States of Alderney.
