**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)  
(Food and Drugs) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Section fifty-five of the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970(b), in so far as that section repeals the Law entitled “Loi ayant rapport aux Préservatifs et autres substances dans les Aliments” registered on the twenty-third day of February nineteen hundred and twenty-nine(c), shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

Certain provisions of the Law of 1970 to have effect in Alderney.
