The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) Ordinance, 1996.

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Law of 1995 to have effect in Alderney

1. The Food and Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1995(b) shall have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Island of Guernsey.

Amendment of Ordinance of 1971

2. The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) Ordinance, 1971, as amended(c), is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) in section 1 thereof, immediately after the words and figures "the Food and Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1975" there are inserted the words and figures "and the Food and Drugs (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1995,";

(b) in the Schedule thereto, for paragraph 6(a) there is substituted:

"(a) the definition of the expression "authorised medical practitioner" is deleted and the following definition is substituted therefor:-

"authorised medical practitioner" means a medical practitioner authorised to practise as such in Alderney according to the law for the time being in force;".

Citation and commencement

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Food and Drugs) Ordinance, 1996, and shall come into force on 1st February 1996.
