Ordinance of the States XLVI 1990

Made	13th December, 1990.
Coming into Operation	1st January, 1991.

The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Benefit) Ordinance, 1990

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

Law to have effect in Alderney

1. The Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990(b) is extended to the Island of Alderney subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out in the Schedule.

Citation

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Benefit) Ordinance, 1990.

Commencement

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st January, 1991.

SCHEDULE

Exceptions, adaptations and modifications subject to which the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 is extended to Alderney

1. In section 3(1), (2) and (4)(a), after “Guernsey” insert “or Alderney”.

2. In section 3(2) after “counted” insert “and any period of residence and presence in Guernsey and any such period in Alderney may be aggregated”.

3. For section 6(2) substitute—

“ (2) The amount of the grant is—

- (a) £8, where the consultation was with a medical practitioner in Guernsey;
- (b) £4, where the consultation was with a medical practitioner in Alderney;
- (c) £4, where the consultation was with a nurse in Guernsey;
- (d) £2, where the consultation was with a nurse in Alderney.”.

4. In section 6(4), 10(2) and 15(2) after “Guernsey” insert “or Alderney”.

5. In section 22(1) for the words following “summary conviction” substitute—

“to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the Alderney uniform scale, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months or to both.”.

6. In section 22(3) for the proviso substitute—

“provided that the penalty in respect of such an offence shall not exceed a fine of level 3 on the Alderney uniform scale or, in the case of a person’s second or subsequent conviction of such an offence, level 4 on the Alderney uniform scale.”.

7. In section 39(1) insert the following definition—

““Alderney” means the Island of Alderney, its dependencies and the territorial waters adjacent thereto;”.

8. After section 39(4) insert—

“ (5) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 applies to the interpretation of this Law and of any Ordinance or regulation made or having effect as if made under it as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.”.
