**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)
(Health Service) (Pharmaceutical)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1990**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of June, 1990, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The schedule to the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Pharmaceutical) Ordinance, 1972(b) is amended as follows:— Increase of prescription charges for Alderney.

Immediately before the reference to subsection (1) of section thirty, the following is inserted—

“In subsection (1) of section 10 for the words “twenty five pence” there shall be substituted “£1.60””.

- Repeals. 2. The Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Pharmaceutical) Ordinance, 1982(c) and the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Pharmaceutical) (Prescription Charges) Ordinance, 1985(d) are hereby repealed.
- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Pharmaceutical) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990.
- Commence-
ment. 4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of August 1990.
