**The Alderney (Application of
Legislation) (Health Service) (Pharmaceu-
tical) Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948(a), hereby order:—

1. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972(b), shall, subject to the adaptations set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance, have effect in the Island of Alderney as it has effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, to have effect in Alderney. Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Health Service) (Pharmaceutical) Ordinance, 1972.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fourth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.

SCHEDULE Section one

Adaptations

In subsection (1) of section thirty—

- (a) in the definitions of “medical practitioner” and “dentist”, there are hereby inserted, immediately after the words “for the time being in force”, the words “or a person practising in Alderney as a medical practitioner or dentist and approved by the Authority”;
- (b) in the definition of “pharmacist”, there are hereby inserted in paragraph (a) thereof, immediately after the words “for the time being in force”, the words “or a person practising in Alderney as a pharmacist and approved by the Authority”.
