**The Alderney (Application of Legislation)  
(Smallpox Vaccination) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Law, 1948 (*a*), hereby order:—

1. The Law and Ordinance set out in the left-hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall, subject to the exceptions, adaptations and modifications set out in the right-hand column of that Schedule, have effect in the Island of Alderney as they have effect in the Island of Guernsey.

Legislation relating to smallpox vaccination to have effect in Alderney.

2. The entries relating to the Law entitled “Loi relative à la Vaccination des Enfants” registered on the ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-five (*b*), in the left-hand column and right-hand column of Part VII of the First Schedule to the

Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948 (c), are hereby repealed.

**Citation.** 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alderney (Application of Legislation) (Smallpox Vaccination) Ordinance, 1967.

## SCHEDULE

## Section one

*Exceptions, adaptations and modifications*

- The Smallpox Vaccination (Guernsey) Law, 1965 (*d*).
- In section one—
- (a) in the definition of the expression “authorised medical practitioner”, immediately after the word “force”, there are hereby inserted the words “or a medical practitioner approved by the States Board of Health”;
  - (b) the definition of the expression “Guernsey” is hereby deleted;
  - (c) immediately after the definition of the expression “prescribed” there is hereby inserted the following definition—  
 ““the States” means the States of Guernsey;”.
- In paragraph (*a*) of section two the word “Guernsey” is hereby deleted and the word “Alderney” is hereby substituted therefor.
- Section six and subsection (2) of section seven are hereby deleted.
- The Smallpox Vaccination (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1967.
- In section one—
- (a) the definition of the expression “Guernsey” is hereby deleted;
  - (b) the reference to the Smallpox Vaccination (Guernsey)

Law, 1965, shall be construed as a reference to that Law as extended to Alderney by this Ordinance;

- (c) immediately after the definition of the expression "parent" there is hereby inserted the following definition—  
"the States" means the States of Guernsey;"

In section three the word "Guernsey" wherever it occurs, is hereby deleted and the word "Alderney" is hereby substituted therefor.

In paragraph (a) of section five the reference to the Law entitled "Loi relative à la Vaccination des Enfants" registered on the ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-five, shall be construed as a reference to that Law as extended to Alderney by the Alderney (Application of Legislation) Ordinance, 1948.

Subsection (2) of section twelve shall be deleted.
